

Booth Sale Checklist

Safety first! Be sure the location is safe for girls, does not block store entrance/exit, and no cashbox or donation jars on table.

- Girls in Girl Scout Uniforms (vest/sash, GS pins, white shirt, khaki bottoms)
- 2 Girl Scout Troop Helpers (registered and background screened) if a Troop Booth Sale
- Event Specifics Requirements
- Booked Booth Sales* and *Booth Sale Location* reports from ABC Smart Cookies
- Cookies
- Cookie Order Card (for nutritional information, taking orders when out of a cookie variety, or to record Cookie Share sales)
- Money belt or apron for adult to wear with money to make change
- Counterfeit Detection Pen with UV Light (see [Counterfeit Money Guide](#) located on gscookiesetc.org/cookies)
