Care to Share is a Girl Scout community service project that allows girls the opportunity to sell *virtual* “Care to Share” nut or candy items that are distributed to our nation’s military and local Orange County food banks. What a great way to help your Troop, Council, and community!

Girl Scout Care to Share purchases are tax deductible and calorie free! Because you don’t eat them yourself, you treat them to someone else. Customers who buy Care to Share can receive a special Care to Share receipt instead of an item.

- * Remember – Only use your first name or Girl Scout Troop # when signing the card
- * Write a short note to the person who will receive the Fall Program items such as:
 - To the Military you might write:
“Thank you for your service!” or “Thank you for keeping us safe.”
 - To a Food Bank recipient you might write:
“Girl Scouts cares about you!” or “Hope you enjoy these special treats!”
