Cupboards

Cupboards will begin opening on Thursday, February 1, 2024 and will not be able to fulfill call-in, email, or drive-up orders.

General information regarding planned orders

The only way to order additional cookies is to place a Planned Order in ABC Smart Cookies with a Cookie Cupboard beginning January 26, 2024.

- ◆ Troops are allowed five Planned Orders per week (a week = Monday—Sunday).
- Place your planned order and choose your preferred pick up day and time in ABC Smart Cookies
- ◆ Enter orders for each cookie variety by the <u>case</u> (12 packages of cookies = 1 case) NO MIXED CASES!
- Cookie Cupboards process Planned Orders in the order in which they are placed online. DO NOT
 place the same order at multiple cupboards. This causes the Council to improperly stock cupboards
 and negatively impacts troops needing cookies. Abusers will lose their privilege of ordering from a
 Cookie Cupboard.
- Please do not change your planned order once it has been placed. Place a new planned order if more product is needed.
- Cookie Cupboard Managers will confirm order, pick-up date, and time via email. Please make sure your spam controls are off to allow cupboard confirmation emails.
- The following procedures will be in place for the health and safety of all volunteers:
 - Cupboards will only be able to accommodate a certain number of planned orders an hour depending on location
 - The cupboard confirmation will have the assigned date and time (not a window of time) for your cupboard pickup. Please be sure to arrive at the cupboard on the date and time assigned. Requested pick-up days and times are not guaranteed until confirmed by Cupboard Manager.
 - * Be sure to read the entire confirmation and look for any special notations from the cupboard manager such as, some locations do require you to wear a mask or may have a change in their pick-up process.
- Respond to the Confirmation Email especially if you need to reschedule your pick-up time or cancel your order.
- Print and bring a copy of the Cupboard Confirmation email with you.



Safely Picking up Cupboard Orders

- Check your cupboard confirmation to see if the cupboard you are picking up from requires a mask when picking up product.
- Only Troop Helper adults who pass background screening are allowed to pick-up product. If you authorize another member of the troop to make the pickup, they must be a registered and screened Troop Helper who is authorized to drive and handle money for Girl Scouts. **Minors may not pick-up product.**
- Count product based on receipt. Do not put the order in your car until after the entire order has been counted.
 - If count is correct:
 - * Take the copy or a picture of the receipt and load cookies into your car. By taking the copy or picture of the receipt and cookies, troop signifies that they agree with the count.
 - If count is incorrect:
 - Notify Cupboard Manager what is missing. They will recount the order, verify it against their reports, and make adjustments as necessary.
 - * Troop recounts their order and takes the copy or picture of the receipt and load cookies into your car. By taking the copy or picture of the receipt, troop signifies that they agree with the count.
- Troop is financially responsible for all product listed on the receipt!
- Check the troop number and Service Unit information at the top of the cupboard receipt is correct before taking the items.
- TROOPS DO NOT ENTER CUPBOARD PICK-UPS. The Cupboard Manager will approve troop's planned order in ABC Smart Cookies within 48 hours.
- Troop orders not picked up on confirmed pick-up date, time will be deleted, and troops will have to submit a new order.
- Distribute late initial and additional orders to girls using receipts.
- Allocate late initial and additional orders to girls in ABC Smart Cookies.
